## Richer, Full & Generous

The ripeness of these wines means that they are very easy drinking and pair especially well with creamy sauces and spicy dishes such as our Thai curry and Local Sausages with Mustard Mash.

**1. Colombard- Chardonnay, One Tree Hill, South East Australia** Soft, easy drinking style with fresh apple and ripe melon flavours.

**13. Cabernet-Shiraz, One Tree Hill, South Eastern Australia.** Ripe, red berry fruit aromas and attractive, soft flavours, in a lighter, easy drinking style.

**14. Rioja – El Coto, Crianza, Spain.** Raspberry fruits and soft spicy flavours, creamy with lovely vanilla notes after oak aging for nine months. Excellent with red meats especially with Lamb.

**15. Cabernet Sauvignon, Le Sanglier Reserve, Old Vines, Vin de Pays De L'Aude, France.** Comes from the wild and remote hills at the heart of the Languedoc region. A delicious wine with minty and slightly leafy rich fruit.
